AMI Day Activities - 1/20/2022

Listed below are activities around the topic of Numbers. We hope that you and your child have fun with these activities.	
"How Many Steps"	You and your child can count how many steps it takes to go from the bathroom to the kitchen, bedroom to the living room, etc.
"What's in the Laundry?"	After laundry, you and your child can sort the clothing by socks, shirts, pants, etc. After sorting, count how many clothing items are in each pile. After counting, determine which pile has the most/least.
Count your snack	Parents and child can count how many chips/goldfish/animal crackers/etc they have for snack/dinner. Gather your family members and work together to count how many fingers/toes are on each person. How many if you count everyone together?
Remote Numerals	While watching TV with your child, grab the remote. Pick a number on the remote and have your child identify which number it is. Next, have your child go and find that things that connect the amount to that number. This connects the visual of the numeral with amount.
"Toy Sort"	Have your child gather their toys. Together, count how many toys your child has. Then, you can sort the toys by categories (ex. dinosaurs, cars, dolls, colors, size).
Number Scavenger Hunt:	Parents can write one number on each piece of paper. Then go throughout the house and place each number (1-10/1-20 if they can handle it) in a different location. Let your child go through the house and find the numbers, making sure they identify it as they go.
Match Numeral to Quantity:	Gather some coins. Parents, write numbers 1-10 on separate pieces of paper. Give your child one of the cards. Have them count out that many coins to match it to the numeral on the card.

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
