- Appointments are reserved for registered Hazelwood Pre-K through 12th grade students.
- All students must arrive <u>at least five minutes prior</u> to their scheduled appointment time.
- All students and accompanying parties must wear masks and practice social distancing at all times.
- All students and accompanying parties must pass an outdoor COVID-19 screening prior to entry.
- Socially distanced waiting areas will be set up indoors.
- Accompanying adults must stay in waiting area with students at all times.
- Mobile Vision Clinic is limited to patients only; no family is allowed on-board.
- If your child currently wears glasses, please bring them.
- Most glasses will be made and dispensed on-site after each child's eye exam!
