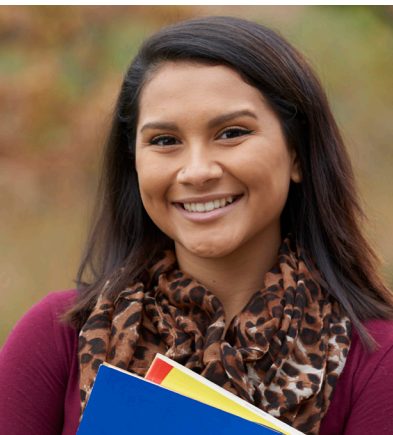


# Dual Enrollment/Early College Information Session for Students and Parents
