CENTRAL HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVE SUPERVISION

Active supervision is the maintenance of a safe, respectful and responsible environment by remaining observant of student behaviors and involved in student communication. This includes interacting with students in your area, encouraging students to move to class, and discouraging off task behaviors that could prevent students from getting to their destination in a timely manner. All staff members are expected to participate in active supervision throughout the day at their designated times and areas, as well as during all transition and passing times.

Teachers should always exit their classrooms with students, remain in the hallways until the next scheduled class begins and greet students for the next period/and when they return from lunch. Adult supervisors should not gather in clusters during supervision. Adults should report to their assigned areas to ensure the smooth transition of students to their assigned destination. If staff members are unable to fulfill supervision responsibilities, an administrator must be notified and an alternative staff member has to be identified.

6:30-7:00 Early Arrival

Entry to Building:

• Students enter through the auditorium doors, or the rear door of B-hall.

Student Location:

- Students must stay in the commons.
- Grab-and-go breakfast is available for all students.

School Personnel:

- 3 before school supervisors, supervise the common area.
- 1 security officer also supervises the commons during this time.

7:00-7:15 Arrival

Entry to Building:

• Students enter through the auditorium doors or the rear door of B-hall.

Student Location:

• Students will transition to their first class of the day.

School Personnel:

- 1 Administrator at auditorium door, 3 administrators in commons.
- 1 administrator in the back of the building, hall B entrance.
- Teachers stand at classroom doors and supervise hallways.
- Security officers and safety monitors positioned throughout the building.
- Safety monitor positioned in PE area.
- School personnel positioned outside of all restroom doors.

7:15-7:25 Beginning of school

- Administrators and security officers inside the building clearing hallways, getting students to designated exits or after school locations.
- Safety monitors sweep all hallways, stairwells, and restrooms.
- Security, safety monitors, and after school supervisors are positioned in the front of the school for late buses and buses that are doubling back.

After school 2:20-5:00

• All students are with a designated teacher, sponsor or coach in a designated location by 2:25 pm.

Activity bus 5:05

• Designated teacher, sponsor, coach, safety monitor, security officer, late night administrator supervise students getting on buses and getting picked up.
