Dr. Patricia Ulrich has been appointed Principal of Hazelwood Northwest Middle School effective July 1, 2021. In her new role, Dr. Ulrich will lead building operations.

Dr. Ulrich brings more than two decades of education experience to the position, including roles as curriculum coordinator, assistant principal, and classroom teacher. Currently, she serves as Director of Curriculum and Educational Programming for Hazelwood School District. Dr. Ulrich holds superintendent, secondary principal, English, and speech and drama certifications.

Dr. Ulrich earned a bachelor's degree in psychology from Northeast Missouri State University and a bachelor's degree in English education from University of Missouri – St. Louis. She also earned advanced degrees from Lindenwood University, University of Missouri – Columbia, and St. Louis University.

Jason Chambers has been appointed Principal of Hazelwood Central Middle School effective July 1, 2021. In his new role, Chambers will lead building operations.

Chambers brings almost two decades of education experience to the position, including roles as interim principal, assistant principal, and classroom teacher. Currently, he serves as assistant principal for Central Middle School.
