Arrowpoint Elementary 2022 Summer School Program

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Purpose

To provide structured, engaging lessons that are focused on the acquisition of grade level standards in the area of ELA, and Mathematics. Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) will also be addressed through the implementation of the Zones of Regulations curriculum. Students will work as team members to solve problems using STEM resources provided by a collaboration with the St. Louis Science Center and Challenger Learning Center.

Attendance Incentive

Each day that students attend Arrowpoint's summer academy, they will receive an incentive. The incentives could range from special pencils, stickers or a notepad. Additionally, if a student has weekly perfect attendance, then he/she will qualify for a drawing (by grade level) for a special incentive.
