Purpose

The Scholars Academy will continue instruction for Pre-K through fifth grade students with a focus on mastery of ELA and Math Standards. The students will be treated and believed to be scholars, as such they will be encouraged to embrace and learn more than one language and they will be exposed to weekly themes focused on Spanish & culture around the United States and around the world. Spanish will be infused throughout the curriculum as students will learn conversational language and vocabulary related to their designs and ELA content.

Learning Strategies

We will utilize the following Instructional & Learning Strategies in Reading and Math that have been found to have a positive impact and potential to considerably accelerate student achievement. The instructional strategies and student learning strategies selected are based on John Hattie's Visible Learning research.

Instructional Strategies

- Small group instruction

- Reciprocal Teaching
- Project-based learning activities focused on STEAM
- Cooperative Learning with strategic groupings such as similar learning styles and similar interests.

Evidence/Measurement of Assessment and Progress Monitoring

All students will be administered Pre-test and Post-test. This will allow all administrators and staff to determine a student's baseline of achievement and current academic level.

During the 5 week summer program each Monday and Wednesday students will complete summative assessments and Friday formative assessments that focus on the standards and CFAs. Progress monitoring be conducted for individual students based upon the standards and CFAs

Teachers will keep a data binder that has academic progress and progress monitoring data on each student. School-wide Jamestown will utilize an electronic Student Data MAP which will have pre test, progress monitoring and post test data on each student PreKG-4th Grade.

All students will utilize Aimsweb to Progress Monitor in ELA if the platform is available over the summer.

Parents will be provided weekly reports of the student's academic progress with explanations and suggestions on how to support their child's learning goals.

Targeted Students

Every student is targeted to participate in the extended school program since every student is likely to have some degree of learning loss. However students who are consistently performing below 70 percent on district assessments and/or who are performing one grade-level beneath their actual grade will be identified to have their parents contacted by their teacher and the counselor. Every student will receive a personalized, mailed invitation to attend the Scholars program.

Strategies Promoting Student Attendance

We will recognize students for attendance by awarding small attendance medals every Friday and a large medal for the end of the program. Every Friday will be a fun day, with things such as a spin of the wheel for prizes. Each class will give out at least four to five prizes. The last day will be a STEAM Fair showcase. Students must attend a designated number of days to attend. The students who attend the STEAM Fair will receive awards and recognitions for their projects but they will also be eligible to receive large prizes such as bicycles, basketball hoop, Slip and Slide and other prizes to promote physical activity.

Strategies to Address Academic Needs of Each Student

We will strive to meet the needs of every student academically through the strategies listed below.

Below Grade Level

- Small group instruction with the classroom teacher (daily 5 times a week)
- Intervention instruction with the Reading Specialist & Math Interventionist (daily - 5 times a week)
- Whole Group Direct Instruction
- Goal Setting

On Grade Level

- Small group instruction with the classroom teacher (every other day 2-3 times a week)
- Whole Group Direct Instruction
- Goal Setting

Above Grade Level

- Small group instruction with the classroom teacher (once a week)
- Small group instruction with the special area teacher for enrichment
- Independent and group projects focused on next grade level standards to allow for students to be exposed to above level standards.
- Peer tutoring and modeling for below grade level students
