New 1st Graders

- * Get on GALACTIC bus at homeschool (except private schools)
- * Stay at GALACTIC from 9:00-12:00
 - * 2 Classes Per Semester
- * Snack/recess midway through morning
- * Lunch at homeschool
- * 1st Graders automatically become day-long 2nd graders

New 2nd Graders

Stay at GALACTIC for a full day from 9:00-2:50, bus transports to and from the home school.

- * 4 Classes Per Semester
- * Lunch and recess at GALACTIC
- * Course selection process students are guaranteed at least one favorite. Please help them understand that not all preferred classes can be assigned.
- * Descriptions of courses will appear on the web site the Friday before classes begin. Teachers do commercials before students sign up. It is helpful to read through the classes to help students have some preferences in mind.
- * Students earn Starbucks (incentives) and may redeem those from the Starbuck cart on scheduled days. A sign-up early pass can be purchased for the fall semester of the 3rd grade year.

Ms. Larry is our counselor and she periodically does lessons in the classrooms. She will be coming around to each classroom early in the semester to introduce herself. There are special newcomer activities.

ROAR - We have a social/emotional curriculum with themes of diversity, equity and inclusion that are taught several times during the year.

Make Up Work - Excused

The work missed back at the home school is generally excused. There may be exceptions such as if an assessment is given that needs to be made up.

If your child is coming home with excessive homework on the days (s)he is at GALACTIC, please let us know and we can send back out to the schools our make-up policies.

Inclement Weather

Just as in the home schools, if an Alternative Method of Instruction (AMI) day is designated by the Superintendent, GALACTIC work will be assigned online.

In order for your child to be marked as present on those days, (s)he must complete the work and return it.

Homeroom teachers will be reaching out to you to let you know how to locate the Google Classroom online and the procedures for completion.

In addition, if your child must isolate or quarantine, similar procedures are followed. The teachers will reach out to you and let you know how work will be handled for GALACTIC. Work is available online. Teachers may be contacted for additional support.
