Subject: Redistricting timeline

After a lengthy study process that included several reports to the Board of Education and two rounds of Community Engagement, the Board of Education is anticipated to make a decision regarding redistricting for the 2019-20 school year at the April 16, 2019 meeting.

Below is information regarding the upcoming timeline regarding the district's redistricting process.

April 16, 2019 - Board of Education anticipated decision regarding redistricting

April 17, 2019 - District communicates Board of Education decision

If the Board of Education decides to move forward with a redistricting option:

Letters are expected to be mailed to all current K-7 students/families notifying them of their 2019-20 assigned school on or about May 1.

Elementary schools who will be receiving new students will hold an open house on May 14, 2019 from 6:00-7:30. Schools are also planning additional transition activities.

Middle schools who will be receiving new students will hold an open house on May 13, 2019 from 6:00-7:30.
