Thursday, April 9th	<p><b>Reading:</b> Read 20 minutes</p> <p><b>Writing:</b> What would you do if you could be a butterfly for a day? Where would you go?</p> <p><b>Math:</b> Come up with a survey question. (Would you rather..) Ask your family members, collect the data.</p>
Tuesday, April 14th	<p><b>Reading:</b> Read 20 minutes</p> <p><b>Math:</b> Use your data results from yesterday and create a representation. (Remember a title, label each choice, show the number of responses for each choice. Share the final product with a family member.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> What is your favorite animal? Why? Draw a picture of it and label its features. (ex. Feathers, wings, paws) Write in your notebook.</p>

<p>Wednesday, April 15th</p>	<p><b>Reading:</b> Read 20 minutes</p> <p><b>Math:</b> Make your schedule for the day. (5 different times on the <b>hour</b>) Write in your notebook.</p>  <p><b>SS:</b> Make a list of your responsibilities at home.</p>
<p>Thursday, April 16th</p>	<p><b>Reading:</b> Read 20 minutes</p> <p><b>Math:</b> Make your schedule for the day. (5 different times on the <b>half hour</b>) Write in your notebook.</p>  <p><b>Science:</b> Write a story with at least two characters. Cut the two characters out of paper. Use a flashlight or other light to act out your story with shadow puppets.</p>
<p>Friday, April 17th</p>	<p><b>Reading:</b> Read 20 minutes</p> <p><b>Math:</b> Write out all the double facts from <math>0+0=</math> to <math>10+10=</math> ( <math>0+0=</math> <math>1+1=</math> <math>2+2=</math> )</p> <p><b>SS:</b> Make a list of your parent's responsibilities at home.</p>
