

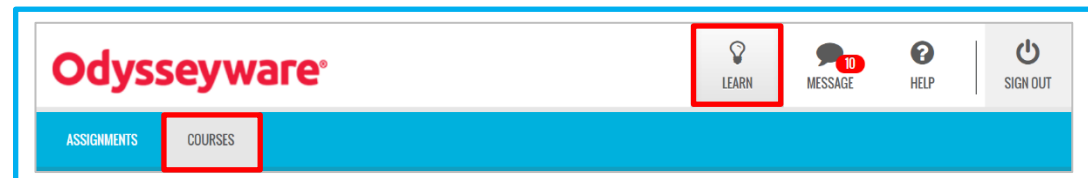


The Learner Dashboard

Quick Start Guide

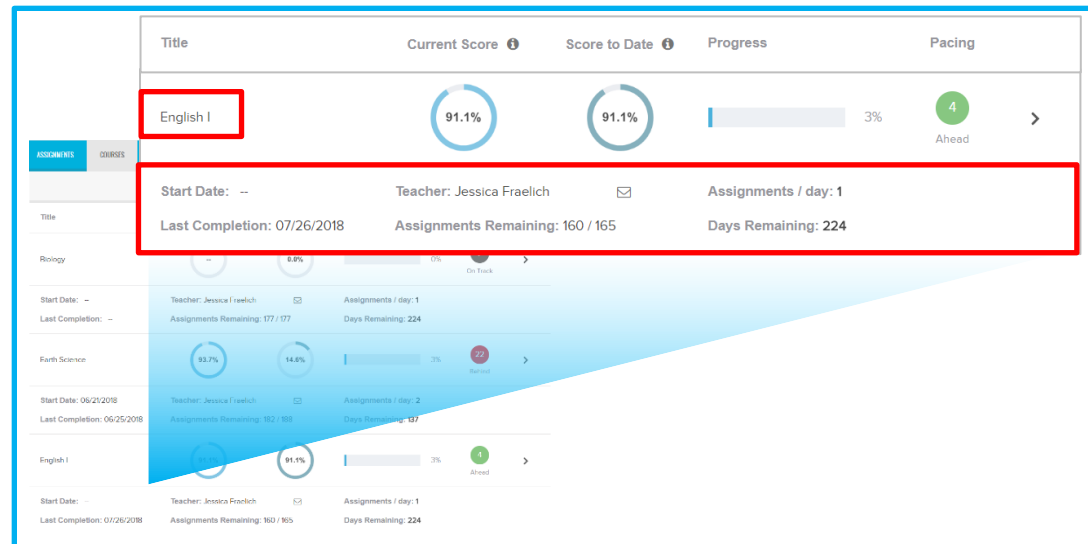
Understand the components of the Learner Dashboard to help empower your students.

1 After your student logs in to his or her Odysseyware site, click on the [Learn](#) tab and then on the [Courses](#) tab. The [Learner Dashboard](#) will be the default view.



2 Students will have access to important [course information](#):

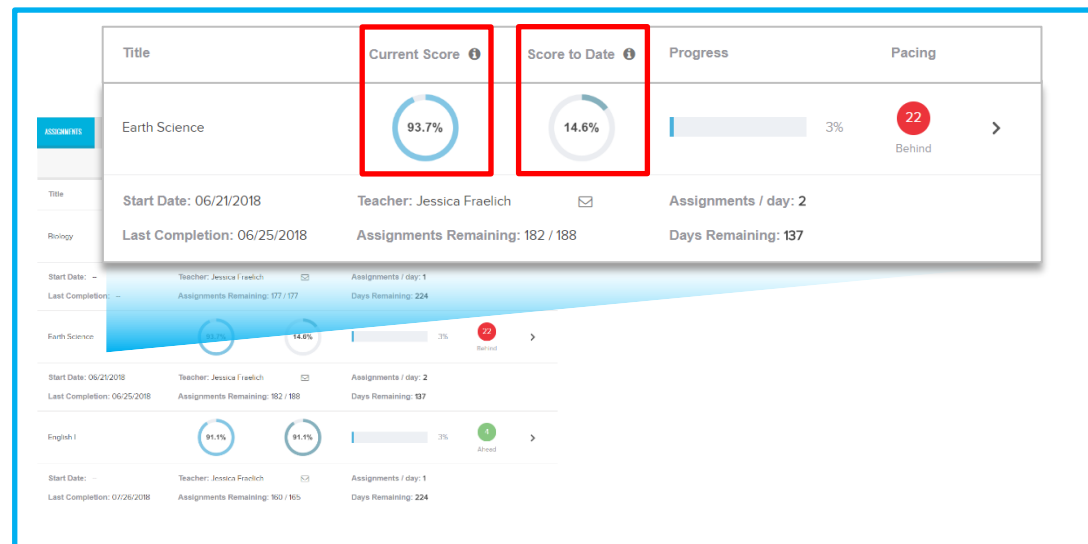
- Enrolled courses
- Course start date
- Teacher of record
- How many assignments must be completed each day to finish the course on time
- Last assignment completion date
- Remaining assignments compared to the total number of assignments in the course
- Remaining days in the Term



3 Students will also have access to [key data points](#).

The [Current Score](#) will show students the score they've earned for all [completed](#) and [graded assignments](#).

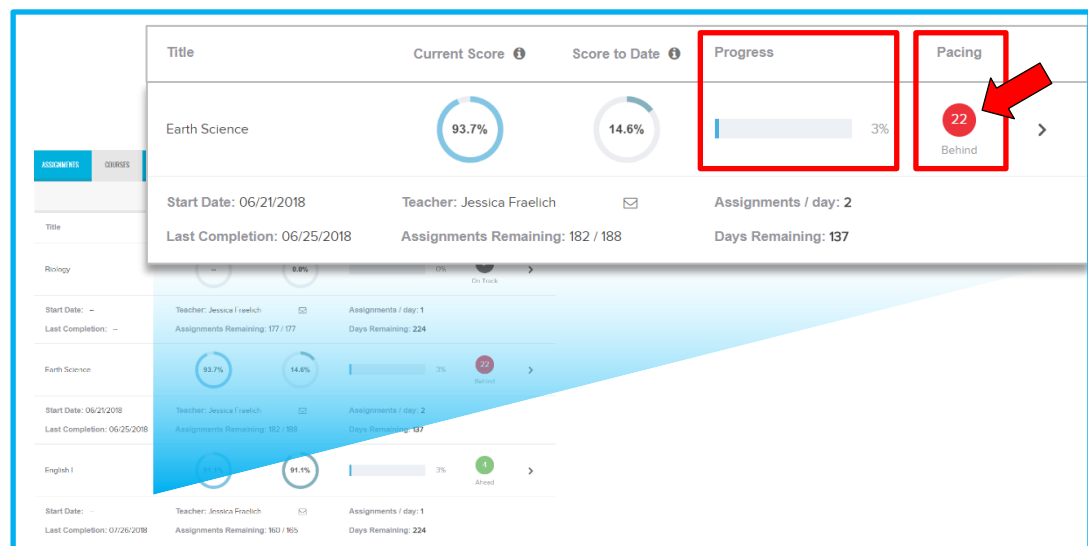
[Score to Date](#) assigns [zeroes for Overdue assignments](#) and factors those into their [Current Score](#). It's your student's true earned score for all [completed](#), [graded](#), and [overdue assignments](#).



4 Students can monitor their [Progress](#) and [Pacing](#).

[Progress](#) indicates how much of a course has been completed.

[Pacing](#) lets student know whether they're working [ahead](#), [on-track](#), or [behind](#). If behind, students can see the exact number of [Overdue assignments](#).



5 Students who have questions or concerns about any of the information they see can [Message](#) the teacher of record promoting easy, open, and frequent communication.
