On May 10, 2018, the Office of Data System Management and the Office of Quality Schools shared <u>Administrative Memo LS-18-001</u> with districts and charter schools to outline the tentative schedule for the 2018 APR data release and appeals process. This memo serves as a follow-up to the original correspondence in light of the delay in establishing cut scores for English language arts and mathematics.
