

NFL Pipelines: High schools with most draft picks over the last 20 years



With four more projected selections into the 2021 NFL Draft, starting Thursday with defensive back <u>Asante Samuel Jr.</u>, the pipeline between <u>St. Thomas Aquinas (Fort Lauderdale, Fla.)</u> and professional football should continue to grow.

The Raiders already far and away lead all high schools nationally in players being drafted since 2001 with 23. Below are all 98 high schools with five or more athletes who have been selected in the NFL Draft over the past 20 years.
