The City of Hazelwood's Community Enrichment Commission (CEC) broke a record by having 43 artists participate in the 15th Annual Community Art Fair held this past Saturday at the Hazelwood Community Center from 10 am to 2 pm. Hazelwood Northwest Middle students got to try out the unreleased Good Expeditions Augmented Reality **HW Northwest Students get Look at Augmented Reality**

Hazelwood Northwest Middle School students, got a sneak peek of the new, unreleased Google Expeditions Augmented Reality (AR). Northwest Middle was chosen among other area schools by the Midwest Education Technology Community and EducationPlus.

Google Expeditions Augmented Reality allows students to use devices to see and interact with various 3D images related to a particular topic in their curriculum. The feature allows teachers to place 3D objects on the students' desks so everyone can observe and examine the objects at the same time.

Students were able to hold and examine the human brain by pointing their AR device at their desks. This feature allowed students to identify the different parts of the brain and explain its functions.

"It was a great honor to have the Google Expeditions Augmented Reality visit Hazelwood Northwest Middle School," said Nettie Collins-Hart, superintendent of schools. "Not only did the students have an opportunity to demonstrate this innovative technology, but unique learning experiences like this will help equip our students with the 21st-century skills needed to be college and career ready."
