

High school student brutally stabs his classmate inside the school

Missouri. – Police responded to a high school after receiving a report that a student stabbed his classmate on campus.

The student (whose identity was not revealed) from Hazelwood West High School who stabbed his classmate was detained by authorities.

Nor was the identity of the attacked student revealed, who was rushed to the hospital to be treated for the injuries caused.

The young aggressor was transferred to the St. Louis County Juvenile Detention Center to investigate the reasons that led him to attack his partner. *(Translated)*

The St. Louis police responded to the emergency call from Hazelwood West High School, located on Wildcat Lane, to help a student who had been assaulted with a sharp weapon by another student.

The authorities did not reveal the identity of the attacked teenager, who was taken to the hospital to be treated for his injuries. The student who stabbed his partner was detained by the police to take him to the St. Louis County Juvenile Detention Center to investigate the reasons that led him to attack his partner.

Data revealed by Everytown for Gun Safety, the state of Missouri is working to lower the rates of violence, where weapons are involved and last year it obtained a 26% decrease in homicides.

Although they recognize that more severe laws are lacking throughout the state to control the use of weapons, among people and their access to young people.

The objective of the authorities is to put an end to the violence, so they are looking for strategies to make the community feel safer. One of the points to be discussed is young people from all over the state to share with them that they are working for their well-being. *(Translated)*
