Hazelwood School District Class of 2018 Surpasses Last Year's Scholarship Totals

The Hazelwood School District's (HSD) graduating class of 2018 earned more than \$33 million in college scholarships to date. This record represents the efforts on 1,197 students who will be graduating from one of the three Hazelwood high schools on Saturday, May 19 at University of Missouri-St. Louis. (UMSL)

Hazelwood Central High has 457 graduates who earned \$13,391,596, Hazelwood East High School has 263 graduates who earned

\$5,015,221, and Hazelwood West High School has 477 who earned \$14,884,419.
