

# Where five St. Louis County school districts stand on in-person learning for high school students



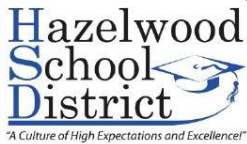
ST. LOUIS COUNTY – St. Louis County Executive Dr. Sam Page announced Monday that high school students now have the option to return to in-person learning and students may also play high-contact sports again.

Here is where a few of the area’s largest school districts stand when it comes to a return to in-person learning for high school students.

**Hazelwood School District** Director of Communications Anthony Kiekow said the announcement has changed nothing in his district. The children will continue to go to school 100 percent virtually. Kiekow said Hazelwood focuses mainly on the zip codes in their area. They are following 63031, 63033, 63034, 63136, 63138, and 63042. The infection case rate on September 14 in those zip codes ranged from 22% to 29%.

On September 15, the Board of Education voted unanimously for Hazelwood students to continue learning virtually. COVID metrics are discussed at each board meeting. The next meeting is Tuesday, October 6.
