

In 2018, Hazelwood School District added the High School Gifted Teacher position. This teacher provides the following services to students in HSD who meet the district's gifted program criteria:

1. Provides services targeting the social/emotional needs of identified gifted students
2. Establishes job shadowing and mentoring opportunities through the selection, planning, and scheduling of college entrance exams
3. Researches, plans, and schedules educational options such as dual credit courses, distance learning, correspondence courses, and planning
4. Assists with post-secondary school research and/or selection, admissions procedures, and completing scholarship applications
5. Works with regular classroom teachers and modify regular classroom curriculum to meet the needs of identified gifted students
6. Supports goal setting, educational plan development, and monitors student achievement

The Gifted Teacher shares time with the three high schools with a minimum of 150 minutes of availability at each school twice a week. The specialist is also available to provide services at the Opportunity Center.
