

What is the Hazelwood Success Academy?

The Hazelwood Success Academy (HSA) is a full-day alternative education program designed for high school students in the Hazelwood School District who seek academic, social, and personal growth in a small learning environment, and/or are experiencing difficulty in their traditional school setting.

Students will receive instruction from certified classroom teachers and will complete elective courses via the Edgenuity on-line learning program.

The maximum number of students in the program will not exceed one-hundred fifty (150).

How do I apply?

Below are the steps to enrollment in HSA:

- Interested students will meet with their principal and high school guidance counselor. The principal and counselor will review the program.
 - If the student is interested the principal and counselor will meet with the student and parent to review and complete the application.
 - Completed applications will be forwarded to the appropriate HOC staff, including the Director of Alternative Education for review, and processed on a first-come first-served basis.
 - The Director will either:
 1. make a recommendation to the student's counselor for another HOC program.
- OR**
2. move the application forward for continued processing.
- Four times a year (once per quarter) HSA staff will contact the parent/guardian for an interview and intake meeting. Students and their parent/guardian must attend this meeting with the staff of HSA.
 - After the interview/intake meeting HSA staff will host an "open house." Student and parents must attend the open house, prior to the student beginning the program.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Where is HSA located?

A: The Hazelwood Opportunity Center located at 1865 Dunn Road, St. Louis, Mo. 63138.

Q: What are the hours of HSA?

A: The hours of the program are from 7:30 am– 1:40 pm.

Q: Is transportation provided?

A: Yes.

Q: What kind of diploma will my student earn?

A: Students will earn a Hazelwood School District diploma (24 credits).
