

Practicing Spot's Rules

Take Care of Each Other at HOME by:

- Taking care of your younger siblings.
- Making a Valentine's Day card for someone in your family.
- Helping carry in the groceries.
- Helping sort laundry.

Take Care of Each Other at SCHOOL by:

- Helping a friend who is crying by asking them if they are OK.
- Helping a friend who has fallen down or dropped something.
- Asking a friend to play or sharing a toy.
- Working together with a friend to clean up toys or blocks.

Behavior Tips for Sibling Rivalry

- ★ If normal bickering occurs, allow the children the chance to work it out themselves. Be close by to help if needed.
- ★ If the bickering continues, acknowledge both children's feelings and what both children want.
- ★ Have the kids help you come up with the solution to the problem. You may need to assist them in implementing the solution by setting a timer for turn taking. If kids are not able to come up with a collusion, it may be necessary to remove the object. When you are ready to give them another chance, talk about the problem solving prior to returning the object.
- ★ Make sure to praise them when they are playing together nicely. "I like how you two are taking turns and sharing."
- ★ Make sure to make special time for each child individually to spend with significant adults.
