Learning Objective: To teach children what can happen if conflicts remain unresolved

Skill: Social awareness

Tell the children:

It's important to solve conflicts for many reasons. If a conflict remains unresolved, negative feelings remain. Here's what can happen:

- Everyone is "for himself" and sticks to his position.
- No one gets what he wants or needs.
- Emotions flare and tempers get out of hand.
- Feelings are hurt and relationships suffer.
- Violence may result.

If people work together toward conflict resolution, positive feelings and outcomes emerge:

- People listen to each other, respect one another, and cooperate.
- Views are clarified and problems are dealt with.
- Relationships and communication are improved.
- Better ideas are produced to solve the conflict.
- Everyone gets what he wants and needs.

Distribute Activity Sheet 101. When the children have completed it, ask them to share their positive and negative outcomes for each situation.
