

First Grade

On the first district declared AMI day (Alternative Methods of Instruction), students may begin Day 1 of the assignments. Students should complete each bulleted activity in Day 1. Some activities may require adult assistance. On each additional district declared AMI day, students will progress through each day in order and follow the same process by completing all of the bulleted activities for that day. To receive a grade for the work, students must return completed AMI assignments with parent signatures to their teacher within 5 school days of school being back in session.

Day 1

- ELA and Social Studies- Have an adult help you read and answer the questions on “Reading a Map.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes to an adult. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 1.
- Math- Complete Lesson 1 Problem Set
- Science- Read “How animals stay safe” and do Animal Camouflage and Animal Coverings

Day 2

- ELA and Social Studies- Have an adult help you read and answer the questions on “The Difference between Maps and Globes.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes to an adult. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 2.
- Math- Complete Lesson 2 Problem Set
- Science- Read “Ready for Cold Weather” and do, What, oh what should I wear?

Day 3

- ELA and Social Studies- Have an adult help you read and answer the questions on “Seven Large Lands.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes to an adult. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 3.
- Math- Complete Lesson 3 Problem Set
- Science- Read “What lives in a desert?” and “What lives in a Pond?” and do Who belongs in a Desert?

Day 4

- ELA and Social Studies- Have an adult help you read and answer the questions on “Oceans Around the World.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes to an adult. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 4.
- Math- Complete Lesson 4 Homework
- Science- Read “Hummingbirds Small and Special” and “Who wants a spiny snack?”

Day 5

- ELA and Social Studies- Have an adult help you read and answer the questions on “What is a Law.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes to an adult. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 5.
- Math- Complete Lesson 5 Homework
- Science- Read “My three sisters” and do, Are you my mother?
