

Fourth Grade

On the first district declared AMI day (Alternative Methods of Instruction), students may begin Day 1 of the assignments. Students should complete each bulleted activity in Day 1. - Math- Complete Lesson 1 Problem Set
- Science- Read “Animal Instincts” and do the questions after the reading

Day 2

- ELA and Social Studies- Read and answer questions over “Get Out the Vote.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 2.
- Math- Complete Lesson 2 Exit Ticket
- Science- Read “Sensing the world around us” and answer the questions after the reading

Day 3

- ELA and Social Studies- Read and answer questions over “The Mayflower Compact.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 3.
- Math- Complete Lesson 3 Exit Ticket
- Science- Read “The night hunter” and answer the questions after the reading

Day 4

- ELA and Social Studies- Read and answer questions over “Valley Forge and the American Revolution.”
- Reading- Read a book of your choice for 20 minutes. Parents/guardians please complete the reading log for Day 4.
- Math- Complete Lesson 4 Exit Ticket
- Science- Do What on Earth is a biome, and do Biome Sweet Biome and answer the questions after the reading.
