

Hazelwood School District 2023-2024 Dress Code Policy

Student dress code is defined as attire that will not disrupt nor distract from the instructional procedures of the school.

Tops: shirts, sweatshirts, sweaters

- Must cover the torso from shoulder to waist
- No crop tops
- No spaghetti strap tops
- Undergarments and/or waist must not be visible

Bottoms: pants, slacks, skirts, shorts, capris, gauchos and cargo pants

- Pants must cover all undergarments (no sagging)
- Pants cannot have rips/holes above the knee
- Spandex bottoms must be covered by other clothing
- Skirts and shorts must be an appropriate length

The following items are NOT acceptable:

- Flip-flops
- Slides
- Headgear that interferes with the student being identifiable on camera
- Sunglasses
- Dark glasses
- Hats, doo rags, bonnets, skull caps, or bandanas.
- Hoods
- Shoes with wheels
- Revealing or suggestive clothing

***Student attire must not promote/endorse drugs, sex, alcohol, violence, gangs or illegal activities. The school administrator(s) or designee will make the determination if clothing is disruptive, inappropriate, or poses a safety hazard.
