

Uniform Guidelines for 2017-18 School Year

Tops

- Uniform Shirt must have a collar and CANNOT be RED in color.
- Sleeveless shirts are NOT permitted.

Sweaters, sweatshirts, vests and lightweight jackets

- Uniform shirt must be worn under a sweater, sweatshirt, vest or lightweight jacket.
- None of these items can have a hood. Hoodies/clothing with hoods cannot be worn in the building
- Heavy coats are not to be worn during school hours. Heavy coats and hooded items must be stored in the student's assigned locker.
- Articles of clothing cannot contain logos that violate any Hazelwood School District Policy.
- Blankets are not permitted.

Pants, slacks, skirts, dresses shorts, and capris

- Bottom colors include: khaki/tan, blue, black, gray, burgundy, white or plaid.
- Jeans are NOT permitted.
- Bottoms should be worn at the waist.
- Shorts/skirts/dresses must be worn to the knee.
- Yoga pants, leggings (stretchy, form-fitting/skin tight, spandex material) are not permitted.
- Jogging/joggers and sweatpants are only to be worn during physical education class and are not permitted outside of P.E.

Belts, hats, sweatbands, purses, bags and backpacks

- Belt buckles that violate any Hazelwood School District Policy are not permitted.
- Hats, sweatbands, bandanas, shower caps, hair bonnets, and head scarves are not to be worn inside the building.
- Purses, bags and backpacks are not to be carried around the building during the school day. These items must be stored in the student's assigned locker.

Shoes

- Flip flops, house shoes/slippers, slides, or any shoe that poses a safety hazard are not permitted.

ID Badges

- Students must wear current and own ID badge at all times. Students are not permitted to use another student's ID or ID # to receive meals.
- Students will be charged a fee for replacement ID badges.

Dress Down Attire

- Must follow SEMS Uniform Guidelines
- Spirit Day: Must wear spirit wear top with SEMS logo. This can be t-shirt or sweatshirt
- If jeans, joggers, or sweatpants are worn with Spirit wear shirt, skin cannot be revealed.
- Spirit wear does include team uniforms.

Failure to Follow Uniform Guidelines

- Student will be asked to make proper adjustments.
- Parent/Guardian will be contacted to bring student proper attire.
- Failure to make adjustments/repeated violations will result in disciplinary consequences as outlined in the Student Behavior Guide Booklet.
